HOKOWHITU SCHOOL INTERNATIONAL STUDENT POLICY

PURPOSE

The Hokowhitu School Board approves the enrolment of international fee-paying students and is committed to supporting their educational and pastoral needs through compliance with the Education (Pastoral Care of International Students) Code of Practice.

GUIDELINES

- 1. Hokowhitu School will be a signatory of the Education (Pastoral Care of International Students) Code of Practice.
- 2. The principal is authorised to negotiate fees for international students.
 - a. International students are required to pay tuition fees in advance of beginning each term.
 - b. If an international student withdraws from Hokowhitu School before the agreed completion date, the parent/guardian may apply for a refund of tuition fees.
- 3. The managers for international students will have overall responsibility for matters relating to international students and will regularly review the needs of individual students.
- 4. International students will be placed in regular mainstream classes studying the New Zealand curriculum according to their age.
 - a. International students will be withdrawn for specialist ESOL tuition and pastoral care according to their needs.
- 5. Hokowhitu School will carry out a self-review of its adherence to the Code of Practice on a yearly basis, as part of the school's ESOL accreditation requirements
