Overview of Findings

Participation

49.0% of school families responded, representing 49.6% of the school's children. The
participation rate was relatively even from New Entrant/Year 1 through to Year 5, with a lower
response rate for Year 6.

Digital Learning

- 75% of respondents felt that the current number of digital devices in classrooms/ketes was sufficient
- 66% of respondents felt that the school should provide all digital devices in classrooms/ketes

School communication with parents/whanau

- 61% of respondents had a positive view of the school's current Reporting to Parents cycle
- · The most strongly preferred form of communication with home was through email newsletter


- 56% of respondents were positive about the use of food as an educational reward
- 78% of respondents were positive about the use of food as part of the curriculum
- 82 of respondents were positive about the provision of food for general celebrations

Year Level of Responses



- The current number of devices is excessive (there are too many)




Digital Learning

Which of the following statements best expresses your view on the provision of digital devices in your child's classroom/kete?


- All students should bring their own digital device (the school should not supply devices)

- The school should supply digital devices but students should also be able to bring their own devices



I/we believe that the School's current Reporting to Parents cycle meets our needs (i.e. at least 2 face to face learning conferences and 2 written reports each year)









What is your preferred method(s) of communication between home and school?









Healthy eating in the classroom

I/we believe that food can be offered by teachers as an educational reward (e.g. a lollipop for an occasional treat)







Healthy eating in the classroom
