Update from the Principal

Kia ora koutou Ngā mihi kia koutou

Congratulations and thank you to the student council for their mahi and support at last Friday night's disco. Over 300 tamariki attended between the two events! We also had some very supportive parents - I thank you for your help in both preparation and support 'on the night'.

BALLOT FOR OUT OF ZONE ENROLMENTS- 6th September

We have 2 vacancies for out of zone enrolments at each of Years 2/3/4/5/6 for Term 4 of this year. We are also accepting requests for enrolment for out of zone tamariki turning 5 in Terms 1 or 2 of next year. A ballot (if needed) will be held on the 6th of September.

If you know someone who lives 'out of zone' who would like to attend our kura, please encourage them to collect and complete an enrolment form and return it before the 4th of September.

This applies to siblings of current pupils too. Please DO NOT assume we will know when they will be turning 5 and expect us to hold a place for them. Our Board is committed to keeping siblings together, however we do need to have the application in before ballot time, so we don't give their space away to someone else.

COMMUNITY CONSULTATION FEEDBACK

Further analysis of the recent survey -

How satisfied are you with the current arrangements for dropping off and picking up your child/children at their kete?

Responses from **all** respondents indicated 78% satisfied, 14% neutral and 7% unsatisfied Responses from our Māori respondents indicated 72% satisfied, 17% neutral and 10% unsatisfied.

How satisfied are you with the current split time at the end of the school day?

Responses from all respondents indicated 59% satisfied, 31% neutral and 10% unsatisfied. Responses from our Māori respondents indicated 48% satisfied, 31% neutral and 20% unsatisfied.

How important is it to you that Hokowhitu School has a school uniform?

78% of all respondents thought it important, 15% were neutral and 7% thought it unimportant. 62% of our Māori respondents thought it important, 31% were neutral and 7% thought it unimportant.

How supportive would you be of changing to a gender-neutral school uniform?

44% of all respondents were supportive, 34% neutral and 22% unsupportive. 48% of Māori respondents were supportive, 38% neutral and 13% unsupportive.

Thank you to everyone who took the time to participate in this survey last term. I will continue to share responses in the coming weeks.

In addition to sharing these results, we are also looking closely to see if there are patterns and/or areas that we can strengthen further.

BASIC FACT-A-THON

This took place yesterday - it was great to see the increased confidence and speed for the tamariki who have clearly been practising their sheets over recent weeks.

The number of correct answers has been recorded by the kaiako (teachers) and returned home for collection of the \$ pledged. All forms and money need to be back at school by Monday 21st August, and handed directly to the child's whānau teacher.

Thanks to everyone who supported the learning and fundraising. Funds raised currently are being ring-fenced to support the Board with updating our senior playground.




