Last week we were advised by the Ministry of Education that we take additional teacher only days (2 each year) to allow professional development around the implementation of the NZ Curriculum Refresh. The first of these days will be taken on the 24th April. The 25th April is a public holiday commemorating ANZAC day so effectively this means Term 2 will commence for the tamariki on Wednesday 26th April. At this time the Ministry of Education has not advised the date for the second day - however it is likely this will be in Term 3. I will inform you as soon as possible.

Update from the School Board

Tēnā koutou,

It was wonderful to see the school community gather last night to celebrate our students' achievements and enjoy their talents as performers. We are very grateful for the hard work of the school leadership and staff and the members of the Parent Teacher Association that made it such a success.

The School Board met for the last time this year on Tuesday night. One of our core responsibilities is ensuring that every student can attain their highest possible standard of achievement. We meet this need by regularly reviewing reports on student assessment. This time, we looked at data on mathematics, reading, and writing for students in Years 3-6 (the data is anonymous). It's a credit to both staff and students to see that over the course of the year the vast majority of students have been able to achieve at or above their age level for the New Zealand curriculum. We had an in-depth discussion about some areas where there can possibly be further improvements, which will form annual targets for the school for next year, and we ensured that there are sufficient resources available.

In some of our other business, we were able to approve the installation of some shade sails in the central courtyard, in keeping with the school's Sun Protection Policy, and we completed our three-yearly review of the Communication Policy. Tim Foss also delivered his first report as the holder of a new Board portfolio, Risk and Compliance, which is especially focused on our obligations regarding privacy and health and safety.
