IMPORTANT REMINDERS FOR 2024

- 1. The Board has requested that we place more emphasis on correct uniform footwear. Socks should be navy blue, shoes should be black or brown and 'school sensible'. If girls are wearing tights, they are to be plain navy blue tights with feet (NOT leggings). Please ensure the tamariki are wearing these items daily.
- We want to take a positive approach to getting this right, so reminder notes will be sent home regularly if tamariki are not wearing appropriate footwear. Thanks for your support with this.
- **2.** Regulation sunhats are compulsory in Term 1. Hats are available from the school office for \$12.00. No hat, no play. This will be enforced from next Monday, so get your hat sorted before next week.



The programme is a structured skill development program which focuses on maximum participation and having fun, whilst teaching the fundamental skills of the game. The programme is delivered in 2 coloured stages. The children all move through each colour with skill drills and games which increase in complexity and movement.
