### **SUN PROTECTION**

Our regulation blue bucket sun hat is a compulsory uniform item in Terms 4 and 1 of each year. Please ensure your tamariki have a named uniform hat from the first day of next term. Hats cost \$15.00 - they are available from Academy Apparel over the holiday break, or from the school office next term.

Alternatively, you can order a hat on KINDO and we will deliver it to the classroom on the first morning. Our sun safe policy states 'no hat, no play'.

As further protection from harmful rays, we recommend that sunscreen is applied before coming to school too. If you are sending sunscreen in school bags to be applied at break times, we find that the roll-on option is easier for tamariki to manage themselves.

### ICE SKATING: 21st - 25th OCTOBER

Exciting! This was the winning 'whole school reward' chosen by the majority of the pupils who earned strive vouchers this term. We have managed to secure a company called 'Ice Skate Tour' to come to our kura for one week and every child at Hokowhitu School can have two sessions on the temporary rink that will be set up in our hall.

A notice **AND** permission slip will come home on the **FIRST** day of next term. It must be returned to allow your child to access the rink.



# aPlus School Holiday Programme



#### aPlus offers the following School Holiday Programmes:

### **Explorers:**

The aPlus Explorers programme is a mixture of centre-based activities (Stay and Play), and excursions (Out and About), for children 7 years and up. This programme offers a chance for children to experience out and about activities or to have special guests come into the centre to see them.

### **Holiday Fun**

The aPlus Holiday Fun programme is a centre-based programme for children aged 7 years and up. Children experience the camaraderie of peers they will be with most days. They will be involved in simple cooking, building, art experimentation, sports and games, physical literacy, and teamwork problem solving.

### The Small Fry Programme at aPlus -

Small Fry is the aPlus Holiday centre-based programme for **5 & 6 year old** children. The programme is planned and paced for this age group and gives the younger children the opportunity to flourish in the programme without having to compete or try keep up with their older peers. The children will be able to have morning tea and lunch with their older peers and when they turn **7** they will be able to go to the Explorers or Holiday Fun programme.

#### **Awatea**

Awatea is the aPlus programme for ages <u>9 years and up.</u> There is a mix of adventure-based activities (e.g. paintball), excursions (e.g. Ten Pin Bowling, Escape Rooms), sports (e.g. Ultimate Frisbee), and challenge (e.g. Shop, Cook, Eat, Win)! This programme is planned to take the children into a world of DOING, not just looking at it on a screen! Some programmes are capped and this will show when booking.

What to bring to aPlus - Morning Tea, Lunch, Hat, Warm jumper, Imagination

What to leave at home - Toys, Phones, Devices, Best Clothes, the Grumps

Lunch Note for Parents/Caregivers - If you are sending noodles for lunch, we will do all packets of noodles of same flavour in a pot together.

Doing the noodles packet by packet takes too long for hungry children. Just fill out the **Heat and Eat** form at Sign In, so we know what noodles your child has brought with them for lunch. We thank you and the hungry children thank you!!!
