HOKOWHITU SCHOOL SUN PROTECTION POLICY (2023)

PURPOSE

Hokowhitu School Board is committed to providing a safe environment for children by promoting sun protection behaviour, providing protected outdoor areas, fostering sun protection practices, and planning of curriculum delivery.

GUIDELINES

Protected Outdoor Areas

1. The School Board is committed to providing outdoor environments that include a combination of built and natural shading options.

Sun Protection Practices

- 2. Sun protection practices will be adopted during term 1 and term 4.
 - a. Children are required to wear the uniform bucket hat when outside for all free-play and class-based activities, where practical.
 - i. When children do not have a hat they must stay under provided shaded areas.
 - b. Children are encouraged to wear rash tops during the school swimming season.
 - c.Families are encouraged to provide their child with sunscreen for reapplication during the day.
 - d. Teachers are encouraged to model sun protective practices when outside.
- 3. The school will provide staff with SPF30+ sunscreen for outdoor activities during the course of their duties.
 - a. Sunscreen will also be available for children if it has not been provided by parents, but staff will not apply sunscreen to children.

Curriculum Delivery

- 4. When possible, school-based outdoor activities during term 1 and term 4 will be organised for early morning or later in the afternoon.
 - a. Outdoor activities should be held under shaded areas, whenever possible.
- 5. Education outside the classroom (EOTC) activities should include a sun exposure assessment.
 - a. When EOTC or sport-based activities are held off-site the school will provide the school pergola for sun protection, as practical.
 - b. When EOTC or sport-based activities are held off-site children and staff should adopt sun protective behaviours as identified in guideline 2.
